Lorraine Droga came to live in the Blue Mountains in 1992 and immediately reignited her passion for painting. In the ensuing years she established herself as a highly regarded artist both in the mountains and further afield. She has been the recipient of many prizes and awards during this time.

Lorraine is well known for her evocative landscapes and is constantly inspired by the dramatic Blue Mountains landscape and the area's wonderfully distinct seasonal changes. Depending on the source of inspiration she generally works in watercolours or acrylics but finds mixed media well suited to her more fanciful pieces.

Lorraine runs a small gallery called Gallery Lane Leura. Together with local artist Sherrie Ehrlich, she presents continually changing exhibitions of their work.
